1) The parties desire to have their principals conduct settlement negotiations in early May when Plaintiffs' decision makers are in Majuro;


2) Continuing to brief the Summary Judgment Motion at this time will result in possibly unnecessary legal fees and might harden the parties' positions and derail settlement possibilities.

Therefore, the parties request that the Court hold in abeyance the remaining briefing schedule.


The parties agree to submit to the Court a new briefing schedule – if needed – by 31 May.
