On October 5, 2018, with trial only five days away, I granted plaintiff's motion to amend its complaint, but I ordered that plaintiff could only add the newly proposed allegations and newly proposed requests for relief to the original complaint, and that plaintiff could not change any of the provisions of the original complaint.

On October 9, one day before trial, plaintiff filed an amended complaint that was a neartotal rewrite of the original complaint and included a claim for monetary damages that had never before been raised. Plaintiff's amended complaint did not comply with my October 5 order. On the morning of October 10, counsel and I met in chambers to discuss the amended complaint. Plaintiff's counsel stated that he had misunderstood my October 5 order. The October 5 order was simple, clear, concise and easily understandable.

The filing of the non-compliant amended complaint is the sole reason for the unfortunate continuance of the long-scheduled trial in this matter.

Counsel and I developed a plan, which counsel then presented to their respective clients, who approved the same. The plan was then orally stated on the record and approved by all parties and counsel. The plan is set forth below.

## BASED ON THE FOREGOING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The trial is stricken.

2. The amended complaint is filed effective October 10, 2018.

3. On or before October 31, defendants shall file an answer or other responsive pleading.

4. The parties may then engage in additional discovery. All discovery shall be completed on or before May 30, 2019. This means that all requests for discovery must be filed on or before April 30. Any request for discovery filed after April 30 shall be disregarded.

5. All pre-trial motions shall be filed on or before June 30. Any pre-trial motion filed after June 30 shall be stricken.

6. The judge assigned to this case shall schedule a pre-trial conference and pre-trial motion hearing date during the month of July or the month of August. Counsel shall attend. The parties may, but are not required to, attend.

7. A three-day bench trial will be held on September 10, 11 and 12, 2019.

8. Although the judge assigned to the case may alter the dates established in this order, any such deviations are strongly discouraged in light of today's failed trial.

9. Certain facts and legal issues are fully resolved and are no longer subject to dispute. Those facts and issues will be memorialized in a separate order, and cannot be changed or contested.
