CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION (AMENDMENT) (3)
(B) ACT 2016

AN ACT to amend the *Constitutional Convention Act 2015*, in order to include additional proposals for the amendment of the Constitution of the Republic of the Marshall Islands.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

§1. Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Convention (Amendment) (3) (B) Act 2016.

§2. Amendments

(1) Schedule 1 of the Constitutional Convention Act, 2015 is further amended by adding new Proposal 23 to be inserted after Proposal No. 22 to read as follows:

“Proposal No. 23 – Article XI, Section 2 (b): To amend Article XI, Section 2 (b) to stringent and prolong the period of resident as one of the citizenship requirements, from 3 years to 10 years to read as follows:

(b) that he has been resident in the Republic for not less than 10 years, and is the parent of a child who is a citizen of the Republic; or...”

§3. Effective Date

This Act shall take effect on the date of certification in accordance with Article IV, Section 21 of the Constitution.
